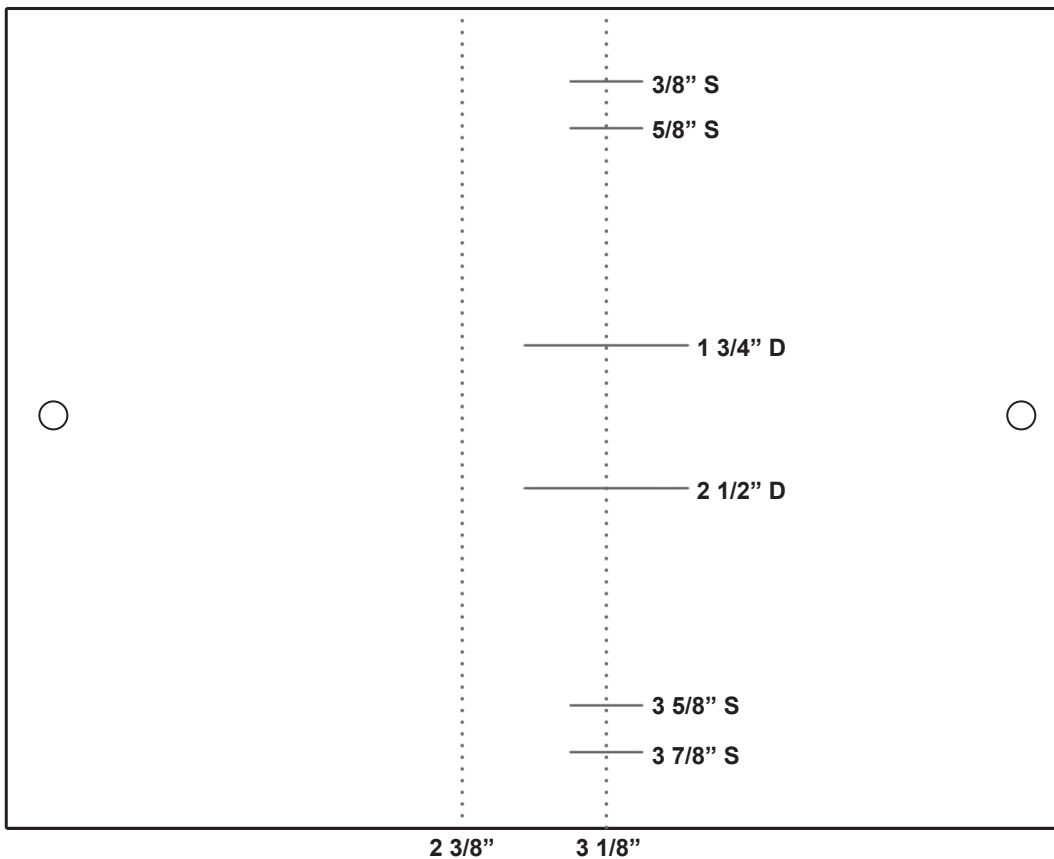


Tube Holder Template

Folds and Cuts:

1. Base cardstock 4 1/4" x 5 1/2"
2. Score along the 5 1/2" edge of the cardstock at 2 3/8" and 3 1/8".
3. Along one of the folds, make four 3/8" Shallow Cuts (S) and two 7/8" Deep Cuts (D) as follows:
3/8" S, 5/8" S, 1 3/4" D, 2 1/2" D, 3 5/8" S, 3 7/8" S
4. Push between the two center (Deep Cuts) and insert tube. Pop the other two up to hold in place and decorate as desired.

TIPS:

- Stamp and emboss a flourish or similar image to show the dimension that embossing adds.
- Adapt the idea by substituting the Transcendence Embossing Powder (shown here) to suit your recipient or occasion.

Suggestions include: Cupcake sprinkles for a "Sweet Sixteen" party, cinnamon or other spices for a baker, beads for a jewelry maker, bath salts or bubble bath for a relaxation or spa theme, Prisma Glitter, Fun Flock, Transcendence Powder (shown here), or Embossing Powder for a stamper.
